## The Tower's Present and Future

The quality of the workmanship and design of the tower has meant that, despite very little maintenance over the last few decades, it remains in safe condition.

Repairs to the roof, the walls, and the moat wall are needed to keep the water out of the building and to make sure it remains safe for the future. The Wish Tower Friends are working with Eastbourne Borough Council on strategies to raise funds.

As a building of the Georgian era, it was never designed to be dry to modern standards inside and it would be prohibitively expensive to try and make it so. As a result, it seems highly unlikely the tower would be a suitable building for precious heritage artefacts which are sensitive to damp.
